FINANCE COUNCIL COMMITTEE AT ST. BRUNO'S MAY 16, 2016

1. Agenda was reviewed. Added 3 items to 11 Old Business [B,C,D].

2. Approval of minutes. Approved, no changes.

3. Catholic Community Foundation – Endowment Fund management. Fr. Ralph will present.

Fr. Ralph explained that this foundation has been around since 1990. It started out with around \$20 million, and has grown to over \$100 million today.

Our current fund has around \$40,278, and is managed by Fidelity.

There was some additional discussion, but no motion or suggestion was made to change our current situation.

4. Need a date set for the Stewardship appeal – will post budget results the same weekend.

Fr. Chuck started the discussion with his opinion that an appeal at this time would not be best due to all the changes that have just happened. (Mass schedule, etc.)

Other options were discussed, and the committee went into “executive session” for discussion.

Results of this session was that we will leave the budget as it is presently, in order to present it to the Archdiocese.

5. Rescue Dog proposal – see handout. Sherri to discuss.

Since we need an “IT” replacement for Dick Stevens, Sherri checked on other avenues of computer support, and suggested that we use the Rescue Dog company for this task. They current work with St. Paul’s School and also St. Bruno’s.

Sherri also pointed out that there will be some excess funds from the admin portion of the budget, and that this would cover the proposed contract with them.

After some discussion, a motion was made to use these funds to prepay Rescue Dog \$4,824 for a 2016-2017 support contract. The motion was 2nd and passed.
